<sup>\*\*</sup>Students may take electives earlier in the program if desired. Students are reminded that <u>half-time</u> status is 5 units per semester. In order to maintain <u>full-time</u> status, students must be enrolled in 9 units per semester. Some external grants, scholarships, and awards may require students to have full-time status. Elective offerings may vary based on faculty availability. Electives typically offered include Practicum V & VI (1SH each) in Yr 4, Counseling Older Adults (1SH), Substance Abuse Detection & Treatment (1SH), Child Abuse Detection & Treatment (1SH), Advanced Human Sexuality (1SH), & Domestic Violence (1SH). Students may also take an additional intervention course as an elective after fulfilling the Yr 2 intervention requirement.
