

Each year, the PsyD program provides 20 Travel Awards in the amount of \$200 each for students who have had their scholarly work accepted for presentation at regional and/or national conferences. This is paid as a flat stipend in the form of reimbursement for expenses. The Travel Awards cycle begins on July 1st of each academic year and remains open for the year until the funds have been depleted. Applicants must provide proof that their scholarly work has been accepted for presentation. Applicants must also provide original receipts for expenses incurred, with reimbursement being made up to \$200. Students may receive only one award per conference for the academic year. Students whose scholarly work has been accepted at multiple conferences may apply for a Travel Award for each conference at which the work has been accepted (e.g. APA, WPA, NCSPP, etc.).
